Reaction from BG veterans to the news was positive, considering our familiarity with the South Course.

As expected, BG2024 MVP Kevin Long was particularly pleased with the news that we'll be returning to the site of his dominant performance last year.

"I love the South Course" Long admitted. "It complements my high-draw ball flight and aggressive putting style. For some reason, I always shoot lower than my handicap there". Long also took the opportunity to confirm that Charles Rodgers would be returning to BG this year.

BlueGrey sophomore Travis Jensen also expressed relief when informed of the venue change.

"The North Course is like a hallway with crystal glassware on either side. The South course allows for shot dispersion, which is obviously more suited for our team".

## Transportation Update

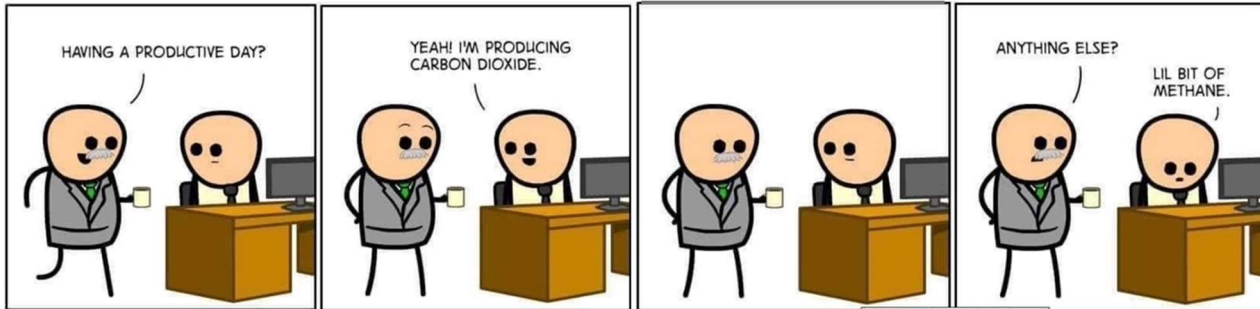
*BlueGrey pivots to a more communal arrangement*
